 land on the one part and the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Robert Carter of the County of  
 Lancaster Esq<sup>r</sup> on the other part. Witnesseth that the said William  
 Manly for & in consideration of the sum of five shillings lawfull money  
 of great Brittain to him in hand by the said Robert Carter the receipt  
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge He hath bargained & sold and by these  
 presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Robert Carter all that tract
