 to my son in law Patrick Spence my pistols & hol-
 sters & breast plate Item I Give to my son in law Thomas
 Spence my silver headed Rapier. Item I Give to Elizabeth
 Colson my old feather bed and bedstead & furniture be-
 longing to it & stuff to make her a ground & pellecate &
 a staff & a pair of shoes Item I Give to my daughter
 Anna Thompson my one bed wherein I now lie & bedstead
 & furniture now belonging to it my will is that if my
 Daughter Alice Thompson shoule marry a Shabby Ran-
 agate fellow she shall receive but halfe her share before
 given her and the rest to be returned to her sister my
 will is the white marsh land which I Surveyed for
 Rich^t Munro which by his own offer was to give me
 halfe he having failed his offer to my desire that
 he should pay five hundred pounds of Tobacco to my
 Ex^r for survey therof. Item it is my will & desire that
 my daughter Anna shoule live & remaine with M^r Sib-
 ellah Pearce until she attaines to the age of twenty years
 unles^s she shal^t marry to W^m Pearce & his wife's living
