 the transitory state of this life do commend my self to God
 my maker hoping to purchase pardon for all my past sins
 and offences through the meritorious death & passion of his
 blessed son and my saviour Jesus Christ into whose hands I
 commend my spirit - I m^t my will is my body be decently

Buried and all my last debts duly paid by my self
 hereafter mentioned first I give & bequeath to my two sisters Mary
 Thornbury & Eliza. Hicking all my new Linen my shroud
 ing lining only excepted out of it and my two trunks to
 be equally divided between them 2^d I Give unto Sam^l
 Wheeler son of Mr. Wheeler my bed and all that belongs to
 it my colt & my. bridle and saddle 3^d I Give unto Ann
 Gough my cow & yearling and to Robert Gough her
 husband all he now owns me 4th I Give my mare to my
 sister Eliza. Thornbury 5th I Give all my Close to be equally
 divided between my two brothers William Wheeler &
 Samuel Thornbury 6th my Will is that this small
 estate which it hath pleased God to bestow on me be
 not appraised but be delivered to the parties above
 mentioned as my estate sees convenient 7th my Will
 and pleasure is that my Loving friend Joseph
 Bayly be my ex^r of this my last Will & Testament
 In confirmacion hereof I have hereunto sett my hand
 & feat my seal this 30th day of December 1715 Thomas
 Wheeler made & in the presence of us Robert Finch. Ann Bayly

At a court held for the said County the 29th day of August 1716
 The last Will & Testament of Thomas Wheeler decd was
 presented unto court by Joseph Bayly gent^l. his ex^r who
 made oath thereto and being sworn by the oaths of both
 the Witnesses thereto is admitt^d to Record and upon motion
 of the said Joseph and his performing what is usual in
 such cases Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat^e
 thereof in due form —
