to me by the last Will & Testament of my deceased Husband Samuel
Johnson bearing Date the Day of in the Year of
our Lord 17 Relation therunto had will more full and at large
appear, and furthermore do Warrant & forever defend the said
Slaves to him the said S^r Johnson and his Heirs from the Claim
or Claims, of all & all manner of person or persons whatsoever. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & seal this
Day of May 1790.
