Ann Stone during her Life, and after her death I give the
said Plantation to my Grand Son Berkitt Sell to
him and his Heirs for ever.

Item, I give to my Grand Daughter Ann Berkley the
following Slaves, Viz. Moses, his Wife Jane and Will.

Item, I give to my Grand Son Anthony Payton my old
Plantation as far as the Mill Run, and the three
following Negroes, Viz. Dick, Lucy, & Fanny to him and
his Heirs for ever.

Item, I give to my Grand Daughter Ann Stone the four follow-
ing Negroes Viz. Tom, Peter, Wenny & Lett.

Item I give to my Grand daughter Ann Payton the three
following Negroes, Viz. Jane, Davy, and Aron.

Item, I give to my Grand Son William Sell the following
Negroes, Viz. old Harry and old Judah,

Item, I give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Hudnell the

Supremus, I give to my loving Wife Ann Payton the use of my Plantation where on I now Live, together with the use of any five of my Slaves that she may make choice of during her life together with one full third part of my household and Kitchen Furniture, as also one third part of all my Stocks of every kind. and after her death I give the use of the said Plantation to my Grand daughter Ann Stone during her life, and after her death I give the said Plantation to my Grand Son Berkhitt I'll to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item. I give to my Grand Daughter, Ann Berkeley the following Slaves, Vj. Moses, his Wife Jane and Will.

Item. I give to my Grand Son Anthony Payton my old Plantation as far as the Mill Run, and the three following Negroes, Vj. Dick, Lucy, & Fanny to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item. I give to my Grand Daughter Ann Stone the four following Negroes Vj. Tom, Peter, Wenny & Lett.

Item. I give to my Grand daughter Ann Payton the three following Negroes, Vj. Jane, Davy, and Aron.

Item. I give to my Grand Son William I'll the following Negroes, Vj. old Harry, and old Judah,

Item. I give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Hudnell the following Negroes, Vj. Rose, and Paul, now in her possession with two Fellows named Ben. & Sam,

Item, I give to my Grand Son George Payton all my Land on the East side my Mill with my Mill wheel Land I purchased of Robert Vaulx, and Richard Steele, with the following Negroes viz: Kitt and Milly. to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item, I give to my Grand Son Birkett Pett, the following Negroes, viz: Jack, George, & Judah.

Item, My will and Desire is that after my Wifes decease the four following Negroes she may make choice off may go to the several persons to whom they are given in this my Will.

Item, My will and desire is that all the rest of my Estate not here in given away may be equally divided between the whole of my Grand Children.

Item, My will and Desire is that if either my Grand Child or die without a true lawfully begotten of their Body that their part be equally divided between them that are living.

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint, James Murre William Payne, and John Berkley Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all and every other Will by me here to fore made, In Witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and Seal, this Twenty sixth day ~~of~~ One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight
