1706-1804
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To all to whom these presents shall come I Ashton Lambkin
of Westmoreland County Pennsylvania do hereby shew that for
diverse good causes and valuable considerations I do give grant
and confirm unto my sister Molly Lambkin one Negroe girl
named Doll (but in case my sister Molly Lambkin should die with-
out Lawfull Heir, that the said Negroe shall fall and descend unto
my sister Jean Lambkin) and the Heir of her body lawfully begotten
but in case she die without such Heir, then the said Negroe shall fall
and descend to Tilda Matt Daughter of Tabitha Stott and the Heir
of her body lawfully begotten for ever, and I the said Ashton Lam-
bkin do covenant, promise and agree to give Grant and confirm
unto the said Tilda Matt the aforesaid Negroe Doll (but if in law
fully and lawfully to have, hold, Use, Occupy, possess and
enjoy for ever, without any let, Hindrance or Interruption of
any person or persons claiming or to claim by from or under
me, my Heir or Assigns. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and Seal this 26th Day of January 1773
