THE 1739-40 RENT ROLL FOR COPLE PARISH, WESTMORELAND COUNTY

Transcribed by Craig Partridge El Cerrito, California

In the Northern Neck during the Proprietorship, the Proprietor collected an annual rent from property holders (akin to the quit rents collected in the rest of Virginia). This transcription of the rent roll entitled "A Rentroll for the parish of Cople from Michaelmas 1739 to Michaelmas 1740, Westmorland [sic]" is reproduced by permission of *The Huntington Library, San Marino, California*, which has graciously allowed me to transcribe it for publication.

The Huntington manuscript appears to be a copy of the instructions sent to the rent collector. In particular, while the manuscript has space to record what rents were paid and note changes in property ownership, these spaces were left blank. The manuscript simply lists each land holder, the acreage held, and notes any amounts in arrears from previous years.

While one cannot be certain, the manuscript appears to have been composed by copying the old rent roll and updating it as the writer went along, presumably from other sources of information such as a list of land transactions. This approach would explain why a few entries, most notably those for the Ayris and Kenner orphans, are placed out of order. They were inserted when the compiler discovered them.¹

The actual date of composition is uncertain, since it appears the compiler was not local to the parish. There are some major errors in names clustered in one spot in the manuscript and probably due to difficulty reading the previous year's roll. A local resident would have known the correct names, but the

¹The case of the Ayris and Kenner orphans is particularly striking. They appear following Captain Footman, who is John Footman who died in October or November 1739 and is the last person whose probate is recorded (see Augusta B. Fothergill, Wills of Westmoreland County, Virginia, 1654-1800 [n.p., 1925; Baltimore, 1973], p. 108). It hints of a separate document that listed these three probates together. Another entry that suggests the compiler was combining an original roll with updates is that of George Walter, where the compiler inserts a note that Walter is also due to pay on 1506 acres in Prince William County. It seems likely this information would normally be in the Prince William rent roll.

compiler had to guess. However, it is clear that the compiler's information included local events through Dec. 1739 or Jan. 1739/40 but not much after that, as deaths that occurred in the late winter are not reflected in the roll. So the roll lists the executors of John Footman (will of 19 Oct. 1739, proved 27 Nov. 1739) and notes that Patrick Spence (will of 10 Dec. 1739, proved 25 March 1740) was dead, but treats Gerrard Hutt (will of 15 Nov. 1739, proved 25 March 1740) and Lawrence Washington (will of 5 Feb. 1739/40, proved 24 June 1740) as living. Allowing for some time for information to reach the compiler of the roll, it seems likely the roll was written in January or February 1739/40.

The transcription is of the first, second and fifth columns of the rent roll (the only three columns used). These three columns were entitled "Landholders names," "No. Acres," and "Reasons for non-payment & property is altered & how." Holdings of multiple tracts are usually noted under the line on which the name appears but sometimes were entered on the line above.

⁴ Haselbrigg is meant to be Haselrigg. Richard Haselrigg was mentioned in the will of William Edwards in 1733, and returned the inventory of the estate of James Haselrigg in 1713 (Fothergill, op. cit., pp. 51, 98). This error is the start of a series of errors in which four of fourteen names are notably misspelled and suggests that the original roll from which this roll was produced was damaged or hard to read in this section.

⁵ Anne's last name was Kirk. She was the widow of Edward Kirk, whose will was proved 28 May 1734 (Fothergill, op. cit., p. 98).

⁶ Mary's last name was Lynton or Linton. She was the widow of William Linton, whose will was proved 26 March 1734 (Fothergill, op. cit., p. 98).

⁷ It seems likely that John's last name was actually Lewis. John Lewis was one of the sons of Surles Lewis, whose will was proved 29 June 1736 (Fothergill, op. cit., p. 101).
