seven Head of Hogs, four Iron Pots, one large Table, and

some Pewter, and all the rest of my Kitchen Furniture

Cattle, Mares & Furniture . . . to have and to hold the said *Negro*

unto the said William Flood . . .

and *I* . . . the said *Jane Esbridge* . . . for *me my*

Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, for ever, do . . . warrant and defend,

against all Person or Persons whatsoever, and by these Presents the said bargained
