Smith Bailey containing ~~Forty~~ ^{Twenty} Acres And the Stock of Cattle, Horses & Hogg. Thence also actual Horse. called the Virginia Sorrel the Younger. And a Sheep called the Betsy. To have and to hold the said enumerated Articles to him the said Stephen Self his Heirs Executors Admin^{rs} and Assigns to his And their Only Proper Use and behoof for ever. Provided Nevertheless, And this is the true Intent and meaning of these Presents That if the said John Nague He & Shall Well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Stephen Self his Heirs, Executors, Admin^{rs} or Assigns the said Sum of Thirty Pounds of Virginia Money as above mentioned with legal Interest thereon. And also discharges the said Self of the Securityship he is now under as above mentioned On or before the first day of May Next ensuing the date hereof. Then this Instrument of Writing and the sole hereof made shall be void and of none Effect. And the said John Nague for himself his Heirs Executors and Admin^{rs} doth Promise Covenant And Vow to stand with the said

Stephen Self has been Executors Adm^r or Assigns that if the said John Wayne has been Executors, Adm^r or Assigns shall and well pay or cause to be paid unto the said Stephen Self his Heirs & Assigns the Sum of Thirty Pounds Current Money of Virginia with the Discharge of said ship, as a bond mentioned on or before the first day of May next. minding the date hereof. And in Default thereof that it shall and may be Lawful for the said Stephen Self his Heirs Executors Adm^r or Assigns to take the said Lands and stock with the other mentioned Articles. And Make Sale of the whole or part thereof to make payment of the whole, or whatsoever may be due the said Stephen Self by the said John Wayne at the said first day of May as aforesaid. Without any such Trouble or hindrance made or to be made by the said John Wayne or any other Person, or Persons forthwith and the Amount of the Value thereof the said Stephen Self his Heirs Executors, Adm^r or Assigns shall have the same Apply toward the discharge of the Debt and Debt of record with legal Interest thereon and if any shall Remain Ever & Above Sufficient to pay the same then such Surplusage shall be paid & Delivered to him the said John Wayne, his Heirs or Assigns In Witness whereof the Parties to these Presents have hereunto set their hands & Seals this day & Year Above Written
