me the ensuing year, ^{should be given} that he should have a
sufficiency of provision out of my Estate to sup-
port him the said ensuing year,

debts are paid, that all the rest of my Estate
be equally divided between my sons Baldwin
Johnston Isaac Johnston, and my Daughter
Jane Hennage, - in witness whereof I have
herunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
sixteenth Day of October, 1790
