the said Cyril Neal, Samuel Carter, Ann Carter,
Thomas Carter, George Carter, Richard Carter, Mary
Carter, Josiah Carter, the following slaves, to wit, to
Cyril Neal, Daniel, Samuel Carter, Milly, to Ann
Carter, Bessy, to Thomas Carter, Minny, George
Cyril, Dinah, to John Carter, Gust, John Carter,
Sam, George Carter, Lann, Richard Carter, Charles,
Mary Carter, Paddy and Marquies, Josiah Carter, Milly
and sold with their and any of their increase to
them and their heirs and assigns, all which slaves
were formerly the property of my father John Carter
deceased and by me sold to the several persons before
named in order of satisfaction for their proportion
able part of the said John Carter's estate. And
I do hereby warrant and affirm the said purchase to be
lawful and valid.

of Westmoreland for and in consideration of the sum
of money to me in hand paid by Betsy
Neal, Samuel Carter, Ann Carter, Francis Carter, George
Carter, Lucy Carter, Prudy Carter, amounting to the
sum of six hundred and fifty pounds, have and
by these presents do bargain and sell unto them
the said Betsy Neal, Samuel Carter, Ann Carter
Francis Carter, George Carter, Richard Carter, Lucy
Carter, Prudy Carter, the following Slaves, to wit to
Betsy Neal, Daniel, Samuel Carter, Milly, to Ann
Carter, Rachel, to Francis Carter, Minny, George
Carter, Dinah, to Saml Carter, Gust, John Carter
Tom, George Carter, Fann, Richard Carter, Charles,
Lucy Carter, Prudy and Marguerit, Betsy Carter, Milly
and Ann with their and any of their increase to
them and their heirs and assigns, all which Slaves
were formerly the property of my Father Saml Carter
deceased and by me sold to the several persons before
named as and in full satisfaction for their purchase
able part of the said Saml Carter's Estate, and
I do hereby warrant to them the said parties and their
heirs
