

Know all Men by these presents that we William Dolman and Thomas Thurman Dolman of the Parish of Cople in the County of Westmoreland are held and stande firmly bound unto Sarah Dolman of the Parish and County aforesaid In the just and full sum of five hundred Pounds - Current Money of Virginia to be paid unto the said Sarah Dolman or her certain Attorney her heirs Executors or Assignes To the which payment well and truly to be made. We do bind our selves and each of us our heirs Executors and Assignes jointly and severally firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 28th day of March Anno Domini 1774.

Whereas our Mother Sarah Dolman has given up and made over to us her whole Right and Title which she has to a certain piece of Land which she purchased of Augustine Mosely the same containing One hundred and seventy one Acres more or less, By a Deed bearing even date with these presents, But we do by this Bond Oblige ourselves to let the said Sarah Dolman have the use of the whole Land for and during her Widowhood, but in case she marries, then we allow her to be intitled to the one third part of the whole Land and plantation for and during her natural life which she shall enjoy without any Interruption of us or our heirs or Assignes —

Now the Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound William Dolman and Thomas Thurman Dolman do stand to and abide by the Above agreements in every respect which is mentioned concerning their Mothers holding and enjoying the Land in manner above said On these conditions the above Obligation is to be rendered void and of none effect otherwise the same is to stand and remain in full force power and virtue —
