

Agreeable to an Order of Westm^o Court, we have divided the Estate of
 of William Monroe deceased, and have allotted Ann, the Widow
 and Heir of the said Monroe, the following Slaves, Landage as
 for her said Heirs and self viz: Philip, Dal, Sam, little Sam,
 and Tom, three Cows and Calves, one yoke of Oxen, and one Horn-
 Mare, 1 Bed and Furniture, 1 Desk, 1 large Table, Spice Mortar
 Tea Kettle, Pot Iron, looking Glass, 6 Plates, 1 Dish, and Tea pot.
 1 glass Bowl, Stone Mill, Spelt, Tring Pan, 10 wooden Plates, 3 Bann-
 4 Dishes, 1 Chamber Oven, Stone Pot, 1 black do. 2 Sugs, 1 Chest,
 6 Chairs, 3 pair Cotton Cards, 3 Wheels, 1 Gin, Room, and 5 Slaves.
 The upper Corn Field, the Home do. one third of the 100th Ground
 to be laid off in the piece adjoining the Orchard, the fruit Trees
 to be counted and so allotted her in any part she may choose.
 The Wood and Timber to be in common for the use of the Plantation.
 To John Monroe Heir at Law to the S^r William we have allotted
 the following Slaves. Aaron, Bill, and Anne, to William Monroe
 Sam, Mandah, Billy, and Louisa of John Monroe, Forty
 Pounds of Pistols, Forty and of Sally eighty, Linn, Manassah, Mary
 Monroe, little Dal, Mine, and to the wife of Sally Monroe one
 Hundred and a sixty pounds; Monagafort. to Sally Monroe,
 Polly, Mitty, Moses, and to pay the sums above mentioned. to
 Peter Monroe, Roger Winby, to pay as above. By consent
 of the parties the residue of the personal Estate has been sold
 and each child's proportion of the cash arising from the
 Sale is eight hundred and sixty seven Pounds fifteen Shillings
 six pence, and one hundred and twenty nine pounds of S^r B.
 Given under our hands this 6th day Feb^r 1781
 Mem^o. We have allotted the Window, the parlour Chamber and Room over
 the Hall, as her one third part of the Dwelling House, and John Heir
 at Law, shall have a right to take a Door from the Chamber of
 under the Stairs as a passage from her part of the } 1st Floor.
