Constitute and Appoint my truly and wellbeloved friends Mark Gooby
John Coke and John Pearson Webb of the City of Williamsburgh my whole
and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
all former Wills whatsoever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
