

Lamb's  
Will.

In the Name of God Amen I Anthony Lamb of Charles Parish in  
York County being very Sick and Weak but of perfect Mind and Memory and  
knowing full well the Mortality of my Body and knowing it is Appointed for all  
Men once to die do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and  
form following.

First I Give my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it me  
hoping through the Merits and Mediation of my dear Redeemer Jesus Christ  
to have pardon and forgiveness of all my Sins and my Body I commit to the  
Earth to be decently buried according to the discretion of my Executor hereafter  
named and as to what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with  
in this life I give and dispose of as follows (meaning after my just Debts  
and funeral Charges are paid and discharged)

Imprimis I Give and bequeath unto my loving Son John Lamb one  
Negro Man named George to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my <sup>Loving</sup> Son Anthony Lamb one Negro Woman  
named Cat and one Negro boy named Frank to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Elizabeth Lamb Thirty  
Pounds to be raised out of my Personal Estate viz<sup>t</sup> my Stock & Household  
Goods but if my Stock and Household Goods do not amount to the aforesaid  
Sum of Thirty Pounds besides paying my Debts then my Will & desire is  
that the said Sum of Thirty Pounds be made up by the Hire of the Negroes  
which I have given to me.

which I have given to my Son but if my Personal Estate after my  
Debts are paid should amount to more than thirty Pounds my Will and  
devise is that the surplus be equally divided among my three Children  
before named And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint John Crepon of  
Elizabeth City County my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will  
and Testament revoking and disannulling all other Wills heretofore made  
by me whatsoever.

Anthony Lamb as his last Will and  
Testament in Presence of us.

At a Court held for York County the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1758.

This Will was proved according to Law by the Oaths of Thomas Somer &  
Hannah Williams the Testifiers hereunto and sworn to by John Crepon the  
Executor therein named, and Ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of  
the said Executor who together with Edward Gabb and James Dixon his  
Securities entered into and Acknowledged Bond as the Law directs a  
Certificate was granted him for obtaining a Probet in due form.
