last Will and Testament being in my perfect Sences It is my will & desire  
that after my just Debts and Funeral Expences are paid that the remaining  
part of what I shall die possessed of be transmitted to my Brother Robert  
Green Merchant in London and it is likewise my desire that Mr. John  
Gibbons and Mr. James Tyre will take on themselves to execute this my  
Will And so hereby revoke all former Wills by me heretofore made declaring  
This to be my last Will and Testament this day of August 1755.

with Robert Ballard his Security entered into and acknowledged Bond as
