 County now in the Possession of Jones Irwin to him and his Heirs
 forever and if he dies without Issue then I Give the said Land to my
 Son Jones Irwin and his Heirs forever. after my just Debts and
 funeral Expences are paid I Give and bequeath to my Daughter
 Margaret Jones Irwin all the rest and residue of my Estate to remain
 in the hands of my Executor til she be of Age, or Married and Lastly
 I do appoint my friend Jones Irwin to be my Executor of this my last
 Will In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
 17th day of May 1748.
