funeral Expences are paid I Give and bequeath to my Daughter

Margaret Jones Irwin all the rest and residue of my Estate to remain
in the hands of my Executor til she be of Age or Married and Lastly

I do appoint my friend Jones Irwin to be my Executor of this my last
