

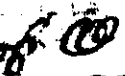
In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Walker

 Acre of Land bounded by the North Side of  
 Quaker Brook in the County of York And is better  
 than a Bill of Sale under my Joseph Prothonotary  
 said the said Land to descend to the I Stephen Walker who  
 he shall come to the Age of Twenty one years when my  
 said Son shall come to the Age of Eighteen he shall  
 have the said and ground to plant on for his own use for  
 his advantage and my Exp<sup>t</sup> to see my said dispose of  
 his labour from the Age of Eighteen untill he is One and  
 Twenty And is a free person or persons shall enjoy the  
 foresaid Land untill my Son shall come to the Age of  
 Twenty one years That the said Land shall be free from  
 any Tax his Land wholly for him and his heirs for  
 ever without enclosing house and One Tobacco pipe for him  
 and his heirs in case my Son Stephen Walker shall  
 die before he shall come to the Age of Twenty one years

fore said Land untill my son John shall come  
Twenty one years That then he shall have for  
said Stephen his Land wholly for him and his heirs for  
ever with out dwelling house and One Tobacco house for me  
table and further in my son Stephen Walker shall  
do without Issue Then I do give and bequeath the  
fore said several Acres of Land to my son John  
Gill and his heirs for ever further I do give to my son  
John Two Towns and one half of one Town and two  
and mark of the Towns One Town being called and known  
by the name of Blackbird Point on the left side and two  
half Towns the Top and Under Point on the right side  
the other Town of the same mark called by the name of  
Henry further I do give to my son Stephen Nicoy  
Two Towns to be called at the head of the Town with  
one feathered one Bull for one Ragg and two yoke of  
oxen One Ox one Long Horn and small Horn

and one Iron pot and one Kettle and three pewter dishes  
and a chest with a fast belt saw and three Red goat skins  
and one Sack and for me one Chayr and one chest and one  
Box stand all which are staid in the house. All which  
Cattle are to be delivered to my Son Stephen when he  
shall come to the age of Eighteen with the female  
Increase from this time and then the Stock to be de-  
livered with all other goods that are now or yett and  
then I doo leave that my Exors. and Adors. to see  
that my Son Stephen doo not Breach any or any  
part or parcel of these Cattle or goods before he cometh  
to the Age of one and Twenty years and from the  
Age of Eighteen my Son Stephen shall enjoy the  
Hale and female Increase. And further I doo make  
Peter Gill my Son in Law my full and sole Exor.  
of my whole Estate. Furthermore I doo <sup>make</sup> ~~get~~  
make my Son John Frost and Richard Frost my Adors.

Peter Gilt my Son in Law my full and sole Executor:  
of my all my whole Estate Furthermore I do <sup>make</sup> give  
bequeath to Joseph Prophan and Richard Prophan Oversees  
of all that is expressed in this my Last Will and Testament  
to be performed by the say Executors Peter Gilt when  
my Son Stephen Walker comes to age Signed this  
5<sup>th</sup> of January 1654
