twenty one I Give and bequeath to my Eldest son William Lee the
Plantation whercon I now live to him and his Heirs forever. Item I Give
to my son William these Negros Frank, Gabo, Cuffee and Stanny to

him and his heirs for ever Item I Give to my son Henry the
Negro viz: Jack Dick Tom and Moll and March Item I Give to
my Son Francis my Negro Maage Harry, Jemmy, Peg, Will, Jerry
and their Increase my Will and desire is that if either of my
Children Die under Age or before Marriage that the Negroes
given to that Child be equally divided between the Survivors my
Will and desire is that all the rest and Residue of my Estate after
my Just Debts are paid be equally divided between my three Children
My Will and desire is that my two eldest Sons William and Henry
maintain my Son Francis in good and decent Cloaths and board
and School him for four years at their own proper Cost equally.
