And for what worldly Estate God hath been pleased to bless me with
I give in manner as follows I give my just debts and funeral expenses
to be paid and the remaining part of my Estate I give & bequeath
as follows I give unto my wellbeloved wife Mary Chairman
my Negro Sarah Nimmo and my Negro boy Tom to her and to the
heir of her body forever also with the Increase of them to her and
her heirs for ever Item I give unto my wellbeloved Daughter
Matilda Chairman my Negro, Esther, Ben. Frank and my Negro boy
Peter with the Increase of them to her and the heirs of her body
lawfully begotten forever if in case my said Daughter should dye before
she comes to the age of Twenty one years or Married Then my will is
that my wellbeloved wife Mary Chairman shall have my Negro Esther with
her Increase to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for and
ever in full satisfaction to me Justa Elizabeth Chairman to her

my Negro boy Frank I give unto my Sister Elizabeth Chisman to have
and her heirs forever and my Negro boy Ben I give unto my Son
John Patrick the son of John Patrick to him and his heirs forever
and my Negro boy Peter I give unto my Son John Chisman son of
my Brother Edmund Chisman by Elizabeth his wife to him and his
heirs forever the remaining part of my Estate I give unto my wife
beloved to be who I appoint whole & sole executrix of this my last will
and Testament looking and receiving of all other debts her before
