Item I Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth the Use of my Negro Wench called M^r
together with her Increase during her Natural life and to her Heirs lawfully begotten
if any such and in case of that failure then to be divided between my surviving
Children or their representatives forever and as to the residue of my Estate I Give
equally to be divided between my three Children Mary Bryan John Roberts and
Elizabeth Roberts or their representatives and lastly I do Constitute and appoint
