 be God for the same do make this my last Will and Testament in manner
 following first I bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it hoping
 through the Merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive full
 Pardon for my past Sins and to bestowing of what Worlty Goods God &
 Almighty has blessed me with I Give and bequeath unto my son Stripling
 Cosby the Plantation I now live on in York County to him and his
 Heir forever in fee simple Provided he Attains the Age of 21 Years
 and leaves issue of his Body lawfully begotten at the time of his death
 but in case he doth not then I Give my said Land to Robert Shelds Jun:
 of York County to him and his Heir forever Likewise I Give the said
 Robert Shelds Jun: Viz: Three Negroes by Name Tom George and
 Jemmy he paying to my Son Stripling Cosby One hundred and twenty
 Pounds Current Money if my said Son Attains to the Years 21 or leaves
 issue at the time of his death lawfully begotten but in case it should
 please God that my said Son should die before he attains to the Age of
 21 Years and leaves no issue at the time of his Death then I Give the
 said three Negroes Viz: Tom George and Jemmy to the said Shelds and
 his Heir forever Item I Give Mary Cosby Daughter of Samuel Cosby
 dec^d twenty Pounds Current Money to be paid out of my Estate after
 my Dec^d but in case the said Mary Cosby should dye before she
 Attains the Age of 18 Years or lawfully Marries the said Money
 to return to my Son but in case he dies before he Attains to 21 Year
 of Age to go to the said Shelds and his Heir my desire is that my two
 Negroes Robin, Hannah and all my Stock Cattle Mares of Horses
 Sheep and Hogs likewise all my Corn and Tobacco to be sold to
 discharge my just Debts by my good friend Robert Shelds Jun: whom
 I do Appoint my whole and sole Executrix this my last Will and
 Testament and I do desire my said Ex^{ce} to take care of my said Son
 immediately after my dec^d and never to let him be with his Mother
 and further it is my desire that my said Ex^{ce} never be called to any Orphans
 Court on the Account of my Son when my Estate that is my two Negroes
 Robin, Hannah and all my Stock and Household Goods Corn and
 Tobacco is sold and my just Debts are paid what remains I leave equally
 to be divided between my Son and Wife Ann Cosby and the thirds of my
 Land to be laid off and she to have one third part and no more and my

desire is that the other part be not Rented to her or Leased on any terms whatsoever
and I do revoke and disannul all former Wills, this to be my last Will and
Testament whereunto I have set my hand and Seal this Thud day of August 1747.

and renounced all benefit and Advantage which she might claim by this Will
and On the Motion of the aforesaid Robert Shields Jun^r the Executor who made Oath
according to Law Certificate was granted him for obtaining a Probate thereof in
due form Giving Security On which he together with Edmund Smith and
Thomas Reynolds Gent his securities entered into and Acknowledged Bond for his
the said Shields due Admin of the Estate of the said Decedent and performance
of his Will.
