Goodwin's will { In the Name of God Amen I James Goodwin of
Yorkhampton Parish in the County of York being in good health of
Body and of sound and perfect Mind and Memory praise be God
therefore for the same I do make and Ordain this my present last
Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
first and Principally I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty
God hoping through him for a full and free Pardon and forgiveness
of all my sins and to inherit everlasting life and my Body I commit
to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter mentioned and as touching the disposition of all such temporal

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I bequeath as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow on me I give and dispose
thereof as follows first I will that my Debts and funeral Charges be paid
and discharged October the 9th day 1757.

Item I Give unto my Son John Goodwin six Negroes Caesar that I bought
of Thomas Wells Hannah in Louisa with her three Girls that is with her &
her Boy Bristol to him and his Heirs forever also I give him one hundred Pounds
Current Money and my Silver hilted Sword and Pistols.

Item I Give unto my Son Peter Goodwin my Land in King William
County to him and his Heirs forever also I give him six Negroes Jack that
I bought of Burras Tom at Louisa one that came from my Mother Caesar
Sealea & Charles that live with him and all that belongs to me on the
Plantation of my Liddy and George to him and his Heirs forever also I give
him my Silver Tankard the large Looking Glass he is to have at his Mothers
death or if she marrieth also I give him thirty five Pounds.

Item I Give unto my Son Robert Goodwin the half of my Land in Louisa
half the Water Mill and five Negroes to him and his Heirs for ever Mr. Paul
Jack James Will and Philliss Youngest Child Betty also I give him a Bed &
furniture that is a pair of Sheets Blanket and Rug and Bedstead also I give
him half my Stock of all sorts that is on the Plantation at my death.

Item I give unto my Son James Goodwin the other half my Land in Louisa

and the other half my Water Mill and five Negroes Viz: Sawney Frank Old Peter Young Peter & Phillis to him and his Heirs forever with the other half of my Stock on the Land in Louisa at my death with one bed & furniture as is aforementioned.

Item I Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Goodwin two Negroes Damon & Sarah to her and her Heirs forever also I Give her two hundred Pounds Current Money to be in the hands of my loving Wife til she comes to Age or Marrieth and one feather Bed and furniture and my young mare.

Item I Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Goodwin two Negroes Viz: Amy and Phillis's Boy James in Louisa to her and her Heirs forever and two hundred Pounds Current Money with one Bed and furniture to be in the hands of my loving Wife til she come to Age or Marrieth.

Item I Give unto my Daughter Diana Goodwin two Negroes Viz: Dick in Louisa and Jenny to her and her Heirs forever with one Bed and furniture to be in the Hands of my loving Wife til she come to Age or Marrieth with two hundred Pounds Current Money.

Item I Give unto my Daughter Rachel Goodwin two Negroes Viz: Merica & Penmaley to her and her Heirs forever with two hundred Pounds and one Bed & furniture to be in the hands of my loving Wife til she come to Age or Marrieth.

I Item I lend unto Anne Chisman two young Negroes viz Charles and Phillis to wait on her so long as she liveth and at her death for her to dispose of them among my Children as she shall think fit.

I Item my Will is that after my Debts and Legacies are taken out that the rest of my Estate I leave in the hands of my loving Wife Elizabeth Goodwin for her to dispose of at her death but if she should marry then my Will is that the three Negroes Cruik Shafard and Sue be valued and let my three Daughters have them paying the Ballance Rebecca Goodwin Diana Goodwin and Rachel Goodwin the rest of my Estate be valued and divided between my Wife and six Daughters Rebecca Goodwin Elizabeth Goodwin Diana Goodwin Rachel Goodwin Mary Inop and Anne Chisman. I Do make ordain Constitute and appoint my loving Wife Elizabeth Goodwin to be my sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made either by word or writing In Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal the Year and date fixed above written.
