 and Funeral Charges are paid and discharged I dispose of my whole Estate Goods
 and Chattels Debts and whatever else I give and bequeath as followeth.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my wellbeloved Brother Robert Crepon the
 Plantation whereon I now live and after the decease of my Brother aforesaid and
 his Wife then I give and bequeath the said Land unto my loving Cousin Thomas
 Crepon Son of the said Robert Crepon to him and his Heirs forever And I do
 Constitute Appoint and Ordain my wellbeloved Brother Robert Crepon my Sole
 and lawful Executor of this my last Will and Testament Rescinding and
 Disannulling all other Wills Legacies and Testaments heretofore by me
 made As Witnefs my hand and Seal this Ninth day of December One
 Thousand seven hundred and fifty one
