 in manner following. After Commending my soul to God in hopes of mercy
 through Christ and my body to the earth I give & devise (my debts and
 funeral Charges being first paid) as followeth Viz^t I give & devise
 I give to William Bryan Son of my Uncle Frederick Bryan my Negro
 Wench Doll and her youngest Son Tom to him & his heirs for ever also
 I give to the said William Bryan my Desk and all my wearing Apparel
 my Gun, sword & Pistols and my Saddle & Bridle Item I give & devise
 my watch to John Bryan Son of my said Uncle Frederick Bryan Item
 I give & devise my house where I now dwell and the four Lots thereto
 belonging bought of M^r. Randolph in the Lifetime of my Mother to my
 Nephew Charles Auden and his heirs for ever on Condition of his paying
 Ten pounds per Annum to my Nephew John Whitehead at his coming of
 Age to help to build him a house on my other four Lots hereafter left
 him Item I give & devise to the said John Whitehead the s^d Ten pounds
 charged on the s^d Auden's Legacy and also my four Lots behind M^r. Rindge
 purchased of Lewis Hollander's debtors to him & his heirs for ever Item I give
 and devise to my Nephew Mary Blackley my Negro Wench Patt to her and
 her heirs for ever Item I give & devise to her Sister Kasper Blackley my
 Negro Boy will to her & her heirs for ever Item I give & devise to her
 Sister Elizabeth Blackley my Negro Girl Betty to her & her heirs for ever
 Item I give to each of the three last Legacies Mary, Kasper & Elizabeth
 Blackley a ring to be provided for them by my Executors hereafter named Item
 I give & devise to my Sister Catharine Blackley my Legacy of Money from my
 Father's Estate lately paid me and also make her my Legatee of all
 my Estate or Claim I might have to any Estate of what Nature or kind soever
 to her & her heirs for ever and I do hereby appoint my said Sister Catharine
 Blackley my whole sole Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby
 revoking all former wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & seal this sixth day of January 1742.
