Ten pounds Curr^t money to my Kinsman John Whitehead at his coming of
Age to help to build him an house on my other four Sotts hereafter left
him Item I give & devise to the said John Whitehead the s^d Ten pounds
charged on the s^d Rudders Legacy and also my four Sotts behind mortgage
purchased of Lewis Hollands factors to him & his heirs for ever Item I give
and devise to my Cousin Mary Blackley my Negro Lench Patt to her and
her heirs for ever Item I give & devise to her Sister Susan Blackley my
house & will to her & her heirs for ever Item I give & devise to her

negro boy will to her & her heirs forever. Item I give & devise to her
sister Elizabeth Blackley my Negro Girl Betty to her & her heirs forever
Item I give to each of the three last Legatees Mary, Susan & Elizabeth
Blackley a ring to be provided for them by my loving hereafter named Item
I give & devise to my sister Catherine Blackley my Legacy of Money from my
father's estate lately paid me and also make her my residuary Legatee of all
my estate or claim I might have to any estate of what nature or kind soever
to her & her heirs forever and I do hereby appoint my said sister Catherine
