commonly called) to my good friend John Blair of the same City Esq^r In trust
that he sell the same in fee Simple for the best Price he can get and apply the
Money arising from such Sale to the Payment of my Bonds to him the said
Blair in the first Place and then for and towards the Payment of a Debt due
by me to the Widow Woodings Estate for which Doctor McKenzie of this
City is security and the Residue if any for and towards the Payment of any
other my just Debts In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this third Day of July 1745.
