herein after mentioned to my Executors to be by them sold to the best advantage and out of the Money arising upon such sale I desire all my just Debts may be first paid and my Will is that the residue including whatever Profits may arise before the Sale be applied to the following uses.

I Give to Mr. Samuel Price of the Town and County of York my Grey Horse and twenty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to be paid him next after my Debts are discharged.

Item I Give to my Housekeeper Mary Rowen my Negro Girl Peggy to her and her Heirs forever and I also give to the said Mary Rowen twenty Pounds Current Money of Virginia.

Item I Give one half of the remainder of my Estate to Peter Bonine and Ghinette Bonine of the Town of Maslaeq in Brearn near the City of Paris in the Kingdom of France to be equally divided between them and if Peter Bonine should be dead I give his quarter part of my Estate to his Wife and if she should be dead I give it to his Sister Ghinette Bonine beforementioned and if she should be likewise dead then my Will is that it be equally divided amongst my three Nieces de Vicat and their Representatives and if none such then my Will is that it go to the Survivor or Survivors of them.

Item I Give the other half of my Estate as yet undisposed of to my three Nieces de Vicat of the same Town of Maslaeq to be equally divided amongst them and if any of them should be dead then my
