Testament revoking and disannulling all former Wills or Testaments by me  
heretofore made in manner and form following and viz:

Imprimis I will that my funeral Charges and just Debts be first paid & discharged  
from I Give and bequeath unto my two Sisters Mary Love and Agnes Birdsong -  
all my Estate of what kind soever to be equally divided between them and their  
Heirs forever and if either of my said Sisters should die without such Issue my  
will is that the Survivor should have the whole.

Lastly I hereby Constitute Ordain and Appoint my good friend Tho: Roberts -  
my true and lawful Executor of this my last In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this tenth Day of April 1767.

Certificate was granted him for obtaining a Probat thereof in due form Giving security Whereupon he together with Bennett Kerby and Richard Pond his security entered into and Acknowledged Bond in the Penalty of One hundred Pounds for his due Admin of the Estate of the said Decedent and performance of his Will.
