Item I Give unto my Son William Pasteur one Negro Girl Named Bebe in
which said Girl was given me by my Brother Thomas Harris dec^d and is now in
the Possession of my Brother John Harris Es^r: of my aforesaid Brother Tho^s Harris
Item I Give unto my two Daughters Martha Pasteur & Ann Pasteur and my
Son William Pasteur the remaining part of my Estate to be equally divided
between them. I do appoint the Rev^d M^r: Commissary Dawson Guardian
to my said Son William and to be left intirely to his care Lastly I do
Constitute and Appoint my Friends W^m. Prentis and Mark Cooby Executors
of this my last Will and Testament and further my Will is that they my
Executors shall not give any security to the Court for their Performances
In Testimony whereof I have set my hand & seal this twenty first day of
March In the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and forty five.
