Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth West my Negro woman called Moll to her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Francis West one Negro man called Joe to her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah West one Negro girl called Sad to her & her heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my Son W^m Davis West one Negro boy called Tim to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to my Son W^m Davis West five pounds to him & his heirs for ever. Item Lastly my will & desire is that all the remaining part of my Estate be equally divided between my before mentioned Children to them & their heirs forever And I do hereby nominate & appoint my Trusty friends John Crawley and James Barber sole & sole Executors to this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourteenth day of Sept^r 1738.
