also I give him my Silver Tankard and my Silver hilted sword and my
new Arms. Item I give and bequeath unto my ^{loving} Daughter Rebecca
Goodwin two Negroes Vizt Paul & Bats and one hundred Pounds in Cash.
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary Goodwin
two Negroes Vizt Frank & Mariah and one hundred Pounds in Cash.
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Goodwin two
Negroes Vizt Diner & Ester & Abraham and one hundred Pounds Cash.
Item after my funeral Expenses and my just Debts paid I give and
bequeath unto my Son John Goodwin all the Remainder of my Estates.

which I bought of William Sheldon Slater to him and his Heirs -
also I give him my Silver Tankard and my Silver hilted sword and my
new Arms. Item I give and bequeath unto my ^{loving} Daughter Rebecca
Goodwin two Negroes Viz^t Paul & Kate and one hundred Pounds in Cash.
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary Goodwin
two Negroes Viz^t Frank & Maria and one hundred Pounds in Cash.
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Goodwin two
Negroes Viz^t Diner & Ester & Abraham and one hundred Pounds Cash.
Item after my funeral Expenses and my just Debts paid I give and
bequeath unto my son John Goodwin all the Residue of my Estate -
my Will and decree is that if either of my Daughters die before they
come of Age or Married that then their part shall be divided between
my surviving Daughters or Daughter. My Will and decree is that
my Executor may complete and finish the buildings on my Land in
York County as I have agreed for and to be paid for out of my Estate
and my Executors shall have the Rents of my Land and the Profits -
