due Administration of the Estate of the said Decedent and performance of his Will.

will - (One thousand seven hundred and forty seven) I Peter Goodwin of Charles  
Parish in the County of York being very sick and weak but in perfect -  
Mind and Memory doth appoint this my last Will and Testament as -  
for my Temporal Estates which it hath pleased God to bless me withall -  
I give and bequeath in manner and form following. Item I give and -  
bequeath to my loving Son John Goodwin all my Land lying in King  
William County and my other Parcel of Land lying in York County  
which I bought of William Sheldon Slater to him and his Heirs. -  
also I give him my Silver Tankard and my Silver hilted Sword and my  
new Arms. Item I give and bequeath unto my <sup>Loving</sup> Daughter Rebecca  
Goodwin two Negroes Dug<sup>t</sup> Paul of Cato and one hundred Pounds in Cash.  
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary Goodwin -  
two Negroes Dug<sup>t</sup> Frank of Maria and one hundred Pounds in Cash.  
Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Goodwin two  
Negroes Dug<sup>t</sup> Diner of Esther of Abraham and one hundred Pounds Cash.  
Item after my funeral Expences and my just Debts paid I give and  
bequeath unto my Son John Goodwin all the Residues of my Estates -  
my Will and desire is that if either of my Daughters die before they -  
come of Age or Marries that then their parts shall be divided between -  
my surviving Daughters or Daughter. My Will and desire is that  
my Executer may compleat and finish the building on my Land in  
York County as I have agreed for and to be paid for out of my Estate  
and my Executer shall have the Rent of my Lands and the Profits -

of my Estate to bring up and School my Children and that my Son John & Goodwin have the benefit of his part of the Estate when he come of age and my Daughters to have their parts when comes to Age or Married. And I do Constitute and Appoint my loving brother, my Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this eighth day of September in the year above mentioned.

Impetratus I will that my funeral Charges and just Debts be first paid & discharged Item I give and bequeath unto my two Sisters Mary Love and Agnes Burdsong all my Estate of what kind soever to be equally divided between them and their Heirs forever and if either of my said Sisters should die without such issue my will is that the survivor should have the whole.

Lastly I hereby Constitute Ordain and Appoint my good friend Tho: Roberts my true and lawful Executor of this my last In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this tenth Day of April 1747.
