In the Name of God Amen in the Year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred and forty seven I Peter Goodwin of Charles Parish in the County of York being very Sick and Weak but in perfect Mind and Memory doth appoint this my last Will and Testament as for my Temporal Estates which it hath pleased God to bless me withall I Give and bequeath in manner and form following. Item I Give and bequeath to my loving son John Goodwin all my lands lying in King William County and my other Parcel of Land lying in York County which I bought of William Sheldon Slater to him and his Heirs. — also I Give him my silver Tankard and my silver hilted sword and my new Arms. Item I Give and bequeath unto my ^{loving} Daughter Rebecca Goodwin two Negroes Viz^t Paul & Cato and one hundred Pounds in Cash. Item I Give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary Goodwin two Negroes Viz^t Frank & Maria and one hundred Pounds in Cash. Item I Give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Goodwin two Negroes Viz^t Dinah & Euler & Abraham and one hundred Pounds Cash. Item after my funeral Expences and my just Debts paid I Give and bequeath unto my son John Goodwin all the Residue of my Estate — my Will and Desire is that if either of my Daughters die before they come of Age or Married that then their part shall be divided between my surviving Daughters or Daughter. My Will and Desire is that my Executors may Compleat and finish the buildings on my Land in York County as I have agreed for and to be paid for out of my Estate and my Executors shall have the Rents of my Lands and the Profits —

of my Estate to bring up and School my Children and that my son John & Goodwin have the benefit of his part of the Estate when he come of Age and my Daughters to have their parts when come to Age or Married. And I do Constitute and Appoint my loving brother ^{John Goodwin} my Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witnes hereof I have set my hand and Seal this eighth day of September in the year abovementioned.
