 my Daughter Mary she shall immediately pay one fourth part of my
 appraised Estate Debts & funeral charges deducted unto the Guardians
 of her said Sons James Quintus & John Lastly I do constitute & appoint
 my said Daughter Elizabeth Farley and my Grandson Edward Farley
 Executrix & Executor of this my last Will & Testament In Testimony
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Twenty third Day of
 August One thousand Seven hundred forty four.

almighty God who gave it hoping through the merits of my beloved
Saviour & redeemer Jesus Christ to receive perfect mansion and
forgiveness of all my transgressions & offences and my body to the
Earth to receive decent burial at the discretion of my Executor
hereafter expressed And as to what Temporal Estate which the Lord
of his great Bounty hath been pleased to bestow upon me I give & I
bequeath as followeth First I will that all my debts be duly paid
and discharged Item I give unto my loving Brother John Calthorp two
Negro's Namely Billy & Rachel to him & his heirs forever Item I
give & bequeath unto my loving Brother Charles Calthorp four Negro's
Namely Tom, Judith, Frank & Sam to him & his heirs forever also
three pounds w^{ch} he hath in his own hands My will & desire is that
the residue of my Estate (my Land excepted) be equally divided
between my two Brothers Charles Calthorp & John Calthorp And
I do nominate Constitute & appoint my loving Brother Charles
Calthorp whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament In
Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this
20th day of October 1744.
