Cumberland and that five Pounds Sterling should be contrived to James
Ransom in London neigh Saint Andrews Church Holborn And the Silver Shoe
Buckles and Knee Buckles I do leave to Eleanor Hall and the rest to
John Clithrell intirely Witnefs my hand and Seal this the 23^d Day of
April in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and forty six.
