and Testament in manner following first my Will is that all
my Just Debts and funeral Expences be satisfied and paid Then I
devise unto such Child or Children as my Wife may be ensient and
with Child of at the time of my decease All my Estate Real and
Personal forever but in case my Wife should not prove ensient
and with Child at the time of my death Then I give unto my brother
Haynes Morgan one Negro Woman named Cate together with her
youngest Child and to my Sister Elizabeth Lawrence Morgan I give
two Negro Girls called Sarah and Frank All the rest residue and
remainder of my Negros with all my Personal Estate I give unto my
dear and ever loving Wife Anna Catherine Turner during her
Widowhood but should she marry again Then I give unto my brother
Haynes Morgan one Negro called Will and to my Sister Elizabeth
Lawrence Morgan one Negro called Abraham I devise unto my dear
and ever loving Wife in case she should not prove ensient and with
Child as aforesaid all my Lands Tenements and Hereditaments situate lying

and being in the County of Warwick for and during her natural Life and
after her death I devise the said Lands to my brother Haynes Morgan and to his
Heirs forever he paying thereout unto my Sister Elizabeth Lawrence Morgan
the Sum of twenty five Pounds Sterling And I hereby Constitute and
Appoint my dear and everloving Wife, Patrick Matthews & George Davenport
Executors of this my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this ninth day of April In the Year of our
Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight.

This Will was proved according to Law by the Oaths of Mary Moor and Thos. Carr
the Witnesses thereto sworn to by Anna Catherine Thurmer & Patrick Matthews two
of the Executors therein named and Ordered to be recorded and on the production of the said
Oaths who together with Thomas Gibbs and George Davenport their Securities entered
into and acknowledged Bonds as the Law therein Certificate was granted them for
obtaining a Probate in due form. George Davenport the other Executor named in the
said Will appeared in Court and refused to take upon himself the burden of the
Executorship
