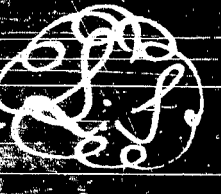


172 In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Corby of

for the same do make this my last will and Testament following
In witness whereof I recommend my soul to God and my body to be decently
buried by my Executors hereafter named. Item I give & bequeath to
my Son John Corby my Land commonly known by the Name of Hope
Island in James City County to him & his heirs but should it please
God to take him from this world before he has heirs or an heir or that
he attain to the Age of Twenty one Years then my will is that
the said Land shall be sold by my Executors for the most it fetch
and that Money to be equally divided between my Surviving Children
viz^t Mary, Anne & Magdalen Corby. Further my will is
the Land I bought of Capt John Laton shall be sold as also all my
Negroes, Stock and Household Goods shall be sold by my Executors
then I give & bequeath unto my four Children viz^t Mary, Anne
John & Magdalen Corby all my whole Estate, not being nominated
to be equally divided between them the said Mary, Anne, John
and Magdalen Corby but to be sold as above mentioned. Lastly
I do constitute my friend William Hooker and

I do constitute and appoint my friends William Hooker and
my Cousin James Corby junr. to be my Executors to this my last
Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
