 my Son John Corby my Land commonly known by the Name of Hope
 Island in James City County to him & his heirs but should it please
 God to take him from this world before he has heirs or on him or that
 he attains to the Age of Twenty one Years then my Will is that
 the said Land shall be sold by my Executors for the most it fetch
 and that Money to be equally divided between my Surviving Children
 Viz^t Mary, Anne & Magdalen Corby. Further my Will is
 the Land I bought of Capt^r John Laton shall be sold as also all my
 Negroes, Stock and Household Goods shall be sold by my Executors
 Item I give & bequeath unto my four Children Viz^t Mary, Anne
 John & Magdalen Corby all my whole Estate, not being nominated
 to be equally divided between them the said Mary, Anne, John
 and Magdalen Corby but to be sold as above mentioned. Lastly
 I do constitute and appoint my friend William Hooker and
 my Cousin James Corby jun^r. to be my Executors to this my last
 Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & Seal this 15th day of March 1742.
