Item I give and devise unto George Gilmer (Son of George Gilmer Surgeon & Apothecary
of the City of Williamsburgh) now gone home to England with Mr. King all the
Goods utensils and every other thing that shall be found in the last new Room
(built by John Collett) at my decease.

Item all the residue of my Estates whatsoever I give and devise to George Gilmer Surgeon Apothecary of the City of Williamsburgh except one Chest of Drawers in the new Room which I give and devise with all it contains to Mrs Gilmer Wife of the said George Gilmer.

Item I give and devise to John Randolph Esq^r Barrister in the City of Williamsburgh a handsome mourning Ring to the Value of five Guineas to be sent for by my Executor or made here if he chooses And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my friend George Gilmer of the City of Williamsburgh to be the whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do desire he may not be Compelled to give any Security for my Estate and I do revoke and make void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made declaring this to be my true and only last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this twentieth day of January 1752 In the twenty fifth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the Second.
