I do Give and bequeath to my good friend Mr Hugh Orr of the City of Williamsburgh and Catherine his Wife Two hundred Pounds Current Money of Virginia I likewise Give and bequeath to the said Hugh Orr and Catherine his Wife one Negro Woman Slave named Sarah together with her Child named Salt to them Their Heirs or Assigns forever. I do Give and bequeath to the abovesaid Hugh Orr and Catherine his Wife two Silver Tumblers and my Silver Watch to them for their proper Use and behoof.

The remainder of my Estate of what sort or kind so ever I Give and bequeath to be equally divided between the said Thomas Hornsby and Hugh Orr for their proper Use and behoof.
