Deathe and I have all I have got and my Will is to give
a beadle & tobacco for a Sermon to be preached in the
New England Church one Sabbath day and also my

 Daughter Mary Ray to be equally divided after my
 Death & my and my heirs & assigns and my Will is to give

 one Cow Calve. And also my Will is to give to my Daugh-
 ter Ann Ray worth one Cow Calve to be delivered
 within two Months after my decease. And also my Will
 is that I give to Mr. Thomas Kirby & Peter Starkey & Henry
 Freeman to be my Executors of this my last Will & Testament
 as witness my hand.
