apply'd towards the Education and Maintenance of my said two children
James & Jane Lastly I do appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Taylor
Sole executrix of this my last Will & Testament and desire my good friends
Mr. Richard Ambler and Mr. Robert Marshdale with the Justice to
