be jointly paid by my following heirs I bequeath to my Sister
Ann Bond three quarters of my real & personal Estate Goods
Chattels Lands Tenements or any thing else whatsoever and
the other quarter of my Estate I bequeath to my Brother John
and Robert Bond to be equally shared between them and I do
appoint my Mother Ann Bond whole Estate to live to this my
last will & Testament Given under my hand & Seal in York
County Virginia this 14th day of July 1743 and in the Seventeenth
Year of the Reign of George by the Grace of God of Great Britain
France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c.
