to the earth from whence it came to be decently
and in orderly order interred
Next I give to my dearly beloved Daughter Ann
the sum of two hundred by name known this day Laine and
to my son and two sons more named Japp and William

I have two former Wills known this day I have and
 I have to me and two former more by name of John
 and Gordon et al and few more named I have also a young
 sister by the name of Colo wth I will make for ever
 have likewise to the same my daughter one daughter
 God wth furniture appertaining to the same all her
 day of marriage after the death of her father and
 after three I will be obliged to her all the day of mar-
 riage with my now dwelling plantation and the land
 there to belonging being two hundred and eighty acres
 as I have at the present I give to the same John and
 his wife to jointly called together with her personal for
 ever. I have also a now wife I give her the
 rest of my Estate moveable and immovable wth my
 land during her life and I do likewise appoint my
 Wife to be full and sole and executrix of my
 last Will and Testament I have hereto subscribed the
 Seal and date this day of November 1655:

after I had turned to to deliver to her all the day of mar-
riage with my new dwelling Plantation and the Land
thereof belonging being Two hundred and Eighty Acres
and I after at the appearance I give to Anne Haden our
Daughter to marry to all the Household with her Inheritance for
ever. I have heard and will be loved wife I give her the
rest of my Estate movable and immovable with my
land during her life and I do likewise appoint my
Wife to be full and sole and executrix of his will
last Will and Testament. I have hereto subscribed this
