 and Merchantable Tobacco of the pipe that is now made that
 the same be sold unto the said Flaggon bought this the good use
 thereof and my name and the said good use thereof which
 Flaggon to be remained to and for the use of the inhabitants
 of York Parish in the church belonging thereto all said of
 the other necessary lands and other.
