will and Testament in manner & form following. I give & be-
queath my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me and my
body unto the earth from whence it came to be againe Risen
at the direction of my last hereafter named Will & give and
bequeath to my loving sons Isaac Hobbs and Edmund Hobbs
all my Dividend or Tract of Land & Tenement & premises in
Yorkhampton parish in York County to be equally divided between
them and Isaac Hobbs to have his choice of parts to them and
the Male heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten for love and for
want of such heir to my loving sons John Hobbs and Thomas
Hobbs and the Male heirs of their bodies lawfully begotten
for ever I give & bequeath to my loving son John Hobbs Twenty eight
Acres of Land in Waverick County joining to Capt. Lays to him and

...the said wife should manage the same
...the remaining part of my estate to be equally divided
between the said son Elizabeth Batchford and Daniel
Robert Hobday John Hobday Thomas Hobday Isaac Hobday and
Samuel Hobday. Lastly I do make constitute and appoint my loving wife
Ann Hobday my whole sole executor of this my last will and Testament
revoking all other wills heretofore by me made In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & Seal this 18th day of May 1758.
