Memory praised be God for the same do make my last Will and
Testament in manner following First I Order and direct all my just
Debts and funeral Expenses to be satisfied and paid Then my Will is
that all my Estate of whatever kind be sold as soon as conveniently
may be after my death by my Executors hereafter named for the most
Money that may be got for the same and the Money from thence
arising to be divided into ten equal parts Eight parts of which I give
equally amongst my Children named John Elizabeth Anne Thomas
Edward Jane Sarah and William and to my youngest Son Benjamin
Calmer I give the Use and Profit of the two remaining parts for
and towards his Maintenance and support until he arrives at the
Age of nineteen Years when I give it to him forever but in case of
his death before he attains the said Age of nineteen Years then my Will
is that it shall be equally divided amongst all my Children and the
survivors and survivor of them And I hereby Nominate Constitute and
appoint John P. Calmer to be one of my Executors and

appoint my Son John Palmer and Son in Law John De Glary Executors
of this my last Will and Testament revoking all former Wills heretofore
made and ratifying this and this only to be my last Will & Testament
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
first day of April in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred &
fifty eight.
