Tabb a Negro boy named Libram to him and his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son William Sheldon Selater all the rest of my
Estate of what Nature or kind soever to him and his Heirs forever except one third
part thereof which I lend to my loving wife during her Natural Life and at her
death to return to my said Son But if my said Son shall happen to die in his
Minority and without Issue then and in such Case I Give to my loving wife
the following Slaves to wit Fish-neck Moll, and her Child, Batten, Sam Ben,

Sam Barber, Malachi, Dan Son of Mary, Bristol & Rachel to her and her disposal
And the Residue of my ^{said} Estate before given to my said Son I Give to be equally

And the residue of my ^{said} Estate before given to my said Son I give to be equally divided betwixt my two Nephews John Selater & Augustine Fabb to them and their Heirs forever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Brother Richard Selater & my two friends Robert Shields and Edmund Fabb Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking disannulling and making void all and every former Will and Wills by me heretofore made In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eleventh day of June 1757.
